

# Chartering

Chartering is the annual process by which churches register their Royal Rangers membership for the coming year. Chartered groups enjoy a variety of unique benefits as noted below. Chartering also provides national, regional, and district leadership teams with valuable information to help them monitor the health of the program and shape its ongoing development and success.

The annual chartering period runs from August 15th to October 31st each year. Groups may charter at other times throughout the year but all charters, and benefits, expire on August 31<sup>st</sup> each year.

## The Benefits of Chartering

The following list highlights some of the many benefits chartered groups currently enjoy.

- 15% discount on Royal Rangers resources purchased through [MyHealthyChurch.com](https://MyHealthyChurch.com).
- 15% discount on registrations at national, regional, and district events and training classes.
- Access to the Outpost Promotional Kit, a resource enabling you to produce top-quality promotional materials for your outpost.
- An official outpost number to wear on your uniform.
- Inclusion in the search results for the "[Outpost Locator](#)" feature on the national web site, which helps families find your church.

## Online Chartering

Before you start the process, the following information needs to be collected.

- Church Account Number
- Number of boys in each age group
- Name and contact information of adult leaders
- Name of your district
- Debit or credit card

## EveryBoy Initiative Donation with Complimentary Charter

To request a complimentary charter, you will need to sign up for the EveryBoy Initiative using the church account number. Since the charter belongs to the church, the donor needs to be the church.

Someone at the church will need to login to their account. The Fund or Missionary to select will be **Royal Rangers, U.S.A.**

Once logged in, they will complete the monthly donation process.

Once the church has setup its monthly recurring donation, follow these steps so your church can receive complimentary charter status for the outpost.

1. The church needs to request their complimentary charter from the National Royal Rangers office ([rangers@ag.org](mailto:rangers@ag.org)).
2. If it is a renewal from the previous charter year, the information from the previous year will be used (leaders, addresses, etc.). If your leaders have changed for the current charter period from last year, please send your updated information to [rangers@ag.org](mailto:rangers@ag.org). Include District, Outpost Number, Leader Name, Leader Position, mailing address, phone number, email address, and the number of boys for each age group. This will allow the district to capture current information.
3. If it is a new AG or approved denominational church, or has been many years since being chartered, please provide all the leaders' information listed in #2 and the number of boys in each age group of the outpost.
4. If the church is a new independent church, please contact [rangers@ag.org](mailto:rangers@ag.org) for an independent charter application.
